The National BSA office has recently made the decision to require all direct contact leaders to complete the BSA training for their position. The stated deadline for this training to be completed is the end of 2011, with the ramification of not being trained by that date being that any non-trained leaders will not be rechartered in their current capacity.

- "Fast Start Training" is required for all leaders
- "This is Scouting" is required for all leaders
- Youth Protection" is required for all direct contact leaders
- Position Specific Training is required for all direct contact leaders
